

## Who are the West Glamorgan Safeguarding Board and what do they do?

Who are we? The West Glamorgan Safeguarding Board (WGSB) are representatives of each of the professionals who are responsible for helping to protect Children and Adults from abuse and neglect across Swansea and Neath Port Talbot.

The main agencies are listed in the below diagram.



What do we do? We are the key statutory mechanism for agreeing how organisations will cooperate to safeguard and promote the welfare of Children and Adults living in the region.

Our Aim To ensure that Children, Young People and Adults in West Glamorgan are protected and prevented from becoming at risk of abuse, neglect or other kinds of harm. The Boards will engage with, listen to and hear the views of Children, Young People and Adults.
